Election and Vote counting procedures

All parents please pay attention to the following election procedures:

- 1. Elector's eligibility: All parents of current students of the School are eligible to vote. Every eligible elector has equal voting right. Every parent should vote individually and should have only one vote irrespective of the number of children he/she has at the School.
- 2. Date of Voting: From 9th to 26th October, 2023 (Before 4 pm).
- 3. Voting method:
 - a) The voting will be conducted by the EClass APP. For details of the vote counting procedures, please refer to Annex 3.
 - b) The voting will be conducted by paper ballot (Only for parents who are not able to use the EClass APP).
 - (i) Electors should cast their ballet paper into the ballot box in person, by post or through their child.
 - (ii) A locked ballot box will be prepared in the school library. The key will be kept by the Returning Officer of the Election Executive Committee.
 - (iii) To ensure election fairness, electors are not allowed to put down their names or any other marks of identification on the ballot paper and should not let other electors see whom they have voted for.
- 4. Date of votes counting: The Returning Officer will conduct a votes counting session in School from 4:15 pm to 4:45 pm on 26th October, 2023. All parents, candidates and the school principal are invited to witness the counting of votes.
- 5. Details of Votes Counting:

A ballot paper will be deemed to be invalid if:

- (i) The ballot paper has been marked more than one voting intention;
- (ii) The ballot paper has not been marked properly, or marked with symbols other than "√";
- (iii) The ballot paper is marked in such a way that the identity of the elector can be traced;
- (iv) The ballot paper has not been marked.
- 6. Announcement of results: The Returning Officer will announce the election result after the votes counting session by informing all parents through the school intranet on 2nd November, 2023.
- 7.Appealling mechanism: Unsuccessful candidate may, within one week of the announcement, appeal to our PTA in writing together with reasons. Our PTA executive committee members will hold a meeting to discuss the appeal.
